 Essential Employability Skills (EES) are transferable skills that provide the foundation of a student's academic, vocational and personal success regardless of their program or discipline of study.

Essential employability skills fall under the following six themes:

- I. Communication
- II. Numeracy
- III. Critical thinking & problem solving
- IV. Information management
- V. Interpersonal
- VI. Personal
- 2. All Post-Secondary programs will teach, reinforce and evaluate the Essential Employability Skills.
- 3. Essential Employability Skills learning outcomes are included on course outlines.
- 4. Program mapping exercises will include identification of learning outcomes for employability skills.
- 5. Essential Employability Skills can be integrated into program course content, or taught as a separate course, in a workshop, or during a course retreat, etc.
- 6. Each program will track the skills on a course and/or program basis through program review.
